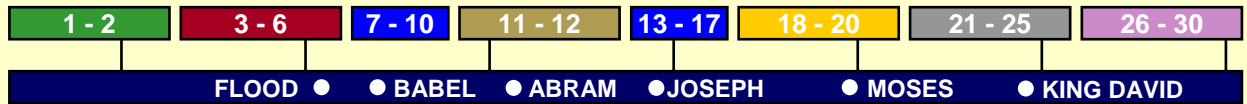


Several Egyptian pharaohs/dynasties may have ruled at the same time in different regions of the land, as Archeologist David Down suggests in his revised chronology

TRADITIONAL CHRONOLOGY – DYNASTIES ARE IN SEQUENCE

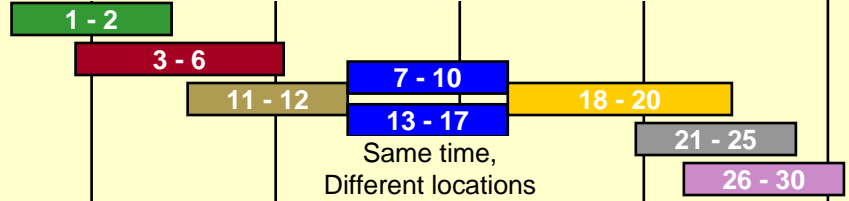
(Based partially on inaccurate/exaggerated king lists of Egypt and ancient Sumer)
