



# Revelation Timeline Passages (NASB)

- Isa 26:19 Your dead will live; Their corpses will rise. You who lie in the dust, awake & shout for joy, For your dew *is* as the dew of the dawn, & the earth will give birth to the departed spirits.
- Isa 65:17 For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former things will not be remembered or come to mind.
- Eze 37:13 Then you will know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves & caused you to come up out of your graves, My people.
- Eze 37:14 "I will put My Spirit within you & you will come to life, I will place you on your own land. Then you will know that I have spoken & done it," declares the LORD
- Eze 38:19 In My zeal & in My blazing wrath I declare *that* on that day there will surely be a great earthquake in the land of Israel.
- Eze 38:20 "The fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all the creeping things that creep on the earth, & all the men who are on the face of the earth will shake at My presence; the mountains also will be thrown down, the steep pathways will collapse & every wall will fall to the ground.
- Eze 38:21 "I will call for a sword against him on all My mountains," declares the Lord GOD. "Every man's sword will be against his brother.
- Eze 38:22 With pestilence & with blood I will enter into judgment with him; & I will rain on him & on his troops, & on the many peoples who are with him, a torrential rain, with hailstones, fire & brimstone.
- Eze 38:23 I will magnify Myself, sanctify Myself, & make Myself known in the sight of many nations; & they will know that I am the LORD.'
- Eze 39:1 And you, son of man, prophesy against Gog & say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "Behold, I am against you, O Gog, prince of Rosh, Meshech & Tubal;
- Eze 39:2 I will turn you around, drive you on, take you up from the remotest parts of the north & bring you against the mountains of Israel.
- Eze 39:3 I will strike your bow from your left hand & dash down your arrows from your right hand.
- Eze 39:4 You will fall on the mountains of Israel, you & all your troops & the peoples who are with you; I will give you as food to every kind of predatory bird & beast of the field.
- Eze 39:5 "You will fall on the open field; for it is I who have spoken," declares GOD.
- Eze 39:6 I will send fire upon Magog & those who inhabit the coastlands in safety; & they will know that I am the LORD.
- Eze 39:7 My holy name I will make known in the midst of My people Israel; & I will not let My holy name be profaned anymore. & the nations will know that I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.
- Eze 39:8 "Behold, it is coming & it shall be done," declares the Lord GOD. That is the day of which I have spoken.
- Eze 39:9 Then those who inhabit the cities of Israel will go out & make fires with the weapons & burn *them*, both shields & bucklers, bows & arrows, war clubs & spears, & for seven years they will make fires of them.
- Da 7:24 'As for the ten horns, out of this kingdom ten kings will arise; & another will arise after them, & he will be different from the previous ones & will subdue three kings.
- Da 7:25 'He will speak out against the Most High & wear down the saints of the Highest One, & he will intend to make alterations in times & in law; & they will be given into his hand for a time, times, & half a time.
- Da 8:14 He said to me, For 2,300 evenings & mornings; then the holy place will be properly restored.
- Da 9:24 Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people & your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision & prophecy, & to anoint the most holy *place*.
- Da 9:25 So you are to know & discern *that* from the issuing of a decree to restore & rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince *there will be* seven weeks & sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza & moat, even in times of distress.
- Da 9:26 Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off & have nothing, & the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city & the sanctuary. & its end *will come* with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.
- Da 9:27 He will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice & grain offering; & on the wing of abominations *will come* one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate.
- Da 12:1 Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands *guard* over the sons of your people, will arise. & there will be a time of distress such as never occurred since there was a nation until that time; & at that time your people, everyone who is found written in the book, will be rescued.
- Da 12:2 Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace & everlasting contempt.
- Da 12:3 Those who have insight will shine brightly like the brightness of the expanse of heaven, & those who lead the many to righteousness, like the stars forever & ever.
- Da 12:6 And one said to the man dressed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, How long *will it be* until the end of *these* wonders?
- Da 12:7 I heard the man dressed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, as he raised his right hand & his left toward heaven, & swore by Him who lives forever that it would be for a time, times, & half *a time*; & as soon as they finish shattering the power of the holy people, all these *events* will be completed.
- Da 12:11 From the time that the regular sacrifice is abolished & the abomination of desolation is set up, *there will be* 1,290 days.
- Da 12:12 How blessed is he who keeps waiting & attains to the 1,335 days!
- Da 12:13 But as for you, go *your way* to the end; then you will enter into rest & rise *again* for your allotted portion at the end of the age.
- Ho 10:8 Also the high places of Aven, the sin of Israel, will be destroyed; Thorn & thistle will grow on their altars; Then they will say to the mountains, Cover us! And to the hills, Fall on us!
- Mt 13:30 ...First gather up the tares & bind them in bundles to burn them up; but gather the wheat into my barn.
- Mt 13:40 So just as the tares are gathered up & burned with fire, so shall it be at the end of the age.
- Mt 13:41 The Son of Man will send forth His angels, & they will gather out of His kingdom all stumbling blocks, & those who commit lawlessness,
- Mt 13:42 And will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping & gnashing of teeth.
- Mt 13:43 Then THE RIGHTEOUS WILL SHINE FORTH AS THE SUN in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.
- Mt 13:49 So it will be at the end of the age; the angels will come forth and take out the wicked from among the righteous,
- Mt 13:50 And will throw them into the furnace of fire; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.
- Mt 16:27 For the Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father with His angels, & WILL THEN REPAY EVERY MAN ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS.
- Mt 24:6 You will be hearing of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not frightened, for *those things* must take place, but *that* is not yet the end.
- Mt 24:7 For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and in various places there will be famines and earthquakes.

# Revelation Timeline Passages (NASB)

- Mt 24:8 But all these things are *merely* the beginning of birth pangs.
- Mt 24:9 Then they will deliver you to tribulation, & will kill you, & you will be hated by all nations because of My name.
- Mt 24:10 At that time many will fall away & will betray one another & hate one another.
- Mt 24:11 Many false prophets will arise & will mislead many.
- Mt 24:12 Because lawlessness is increased, most people's love will grow cold.
- Mt 24:13 But the one who endures to the end, he will be saved.
- Mt 24:14 This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, & then the end will come.
- Mt 24:15 Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place
- Mt 24:16 then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains.
- Mt 24:17 Whoever is on the housetop must not go down to get the things out that are in his house.
- Mt 24:18 Whoever is in the field must not turn back to get his cloak.
- Mt 24:19 But woe to those who are pregnant & who are nursing babies in those days!
- Mt 24:20 But pray that your flight will not be in the winter, or on a Sabbath.
- Mt 24:21 For then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will.
- Mt 24:22 Unless those days had been cut short, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.
- Mt 24:23 Then if anyone says to you, 'Behold, here is the Christ,' or 'There *He is*,' do not believe *him*.
- Mt 24:24 For false Christs & false prophets will arise & will show great signs & wonders, so as to mislead, if possible, even the elect.
- Mt 24:25 Behold, I have told you in advance.
- Mt 24:26 So if they say to you, 'Behold, He is in the wilderness,' do not go out, or, 'Behold, He is in the inner rooms,' do not believe *them*.
- Mt 24:27 For just as the lightning comes from the east & flashes even to the west, so will the coming of the Son of Man be.
- Mt 24:28 Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather.
- Mt 24:29 But immediately after the tribulation of those days THE SUN WILL BE DARKENED, & THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT, & THE STARS WILL FALL from the sky, & the powers of the heavens will be shaken.
- Mt 24:30 Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, & then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, & they will see the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power & great glory.
- Mt 24:31 He will send forth His angels with A GREAT TRUMPET to GATHER TOGETHER His elect from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other.
- Mt 24:40 Then there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left.
- Mt 24:41 Two women *will be* grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left.
- Mt 24:42 Therefore be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming.
- Mt 24:44 For this reason you also must be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think *He will*.
- Mt 25:31 But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, & all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne.
- Mt 26:64 Jesus *said* to him, "You have said it *yourself*; nevertheless, I tell you, hereafter you will see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, & COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN."
- Mr 8:38 For whoever is ashamed of Me & My words in this adulterous & sinful generation, the Son of Man will also be ashamed of him when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.
- Mr 13:7 When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be frightened; *those things* must take place; but *that is* not yet the end.
- Mr 13:8 For nation will rise up against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; there will be earthquakes in various places; there will *also* be famines. These things are *merely* the beginning of birth pangs.
- Mr 13:20 Unless the Lord had shortened *those* days, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect, whom He chose, He shortened the days.
- Mr 13:24 But in those days, after that tribulation, THE SUN WILL BE DARKENED & THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT,
- Mr 13:25 & THE STARS WILL BE FALLING from heaven, & the powers that are in the heavens will be shaken.
- Mr 13:26 They will see The Son of Man Coming In Clouds with great power & glory.
- Mr 13:27 Then He will send forth the angels & will gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest end of the earth to the farthest end of heaven.
- Mr 13:29 Even so, you too, when you see these things happening, recognize that He is near, *right* at the door.
- Mr 13:30 Truly I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place.
- Mr 13:31 Heaven & earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away.
- Mr 13:32 But of that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but the Father *alone*.
- Mr 14:62 Jesus said, " I am; & you shall see THE SON OF MAN SITTING AT THE RIGHT HAND OF POWER, & COMING WITH THE CLOUDS OF HEAVEN."
- Lu 17:34 I tell you, on that night there will be two in one bed; one will be taken & the other will be left.
- Lu 17:35 There will be two women grinding at the same place; one will be taken & the other will be left.
- Lu 17:36 Two men will be in the field; one will be taken & the other will be left.
- Lu 17:37 And answering they *said* to Him, "Where, Lord?" & He said to them, "Where the body *is*, there also the vultures will be gathered."
- Lu 18:8 I tell you that He will bring about justice for them quickly. However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?
- Lu 21:24 they will fall by the edge of the sword, & will be led captive into all the nations; & Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.
- Lu 21:27 They will see The Son Of Man Coming In A Cloud with power & great glory.
- Lu 22:30 that you may eat & drink at My table in My kingdom, & you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Lu 23:29 For behold, the days are coming when they will say, 'Blessed are the barren, & the wombs that never bore, & the breasts that never nursed.'
- Joh 5:28 Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice,
- Joh 5:29 And will come forth; those who did the good *deeds* to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil *deeds* to a resurrection of judgment.
- 1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive.
- 1Co 15:23 But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming,
- 1Co 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.
- 1Th 1:10 And to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, *that is* Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath to come.

# Revelation Timeline Passages (NASB)

- 1Th 4:16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of *the* archangel & with the trumpet of God, & the dead in Christ will rise first.
- 1Th 4:17 Then we who are alive and remain will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.
- 1Th 5:9 For God has not destined us for wrath, but for obtaining salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 2Th 2:3 Let no one in any way deceive you, for *it will not come* unless the apostasy comes first, & the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction,
- 2Th 2:4 who opposes & exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God.
- 2Th 2:5 Do you not remember that while I was still with you, I was telling you these things?
- 2Th 2:6 And you know what restrains him now, so that in his time he will be revealed.
- 2Th 2:7 For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only he who now restrains *will do so* until he is taken out of the way.
- 2Th 2:8 Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth & bring to an end by the appearance of His coming;
- 2Th 2:9 *that is*, the one whose coming is in accord with the activity of Satan, with all power & signs & false wonders,
- 2Th 2:10 And with all the deception of wickedness for those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth so as to be saved.
- 2Th 2:11 For this reason God will send upon them a deluding influence so that they will believe what is false,
- 2Th 2:12 in order that they all may be judged who did not believe the truth, but took pleasure in wickedness.
- Re 1:7 BEHOLD, HE IS COMING WITH THE CLOUDS, & every eye will see Him, even those who pierced Him; & all the tribes of the earth will mourn over Him.
- Re 6:1 Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals, & I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of thunder, "Come."
- Re 6:2 I looked, & behold, a white horse, & he who sat on it had a bow; & a crown was given to him, & he went out conquering & to conquer.
- Re 6:3 When He broke the second seal, I heard the 2nd living creature saying, "Come."
- Re 6:4 Another, a red horse, went out; & to him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, & that *men* would slay one another; & a great sword was given to him.
- Re 6:5 When He broke the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying, "Come." I looked, & behold, a black horse; and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand.
- Re 6:6 And I heard *something* like a voice in the center of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not damage the oil and the wine."
- Re 6:7 When the Lamb broke the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come."
- Re 6:8 I looked, and behold, an ashen horse; and he who sat on it had the name Death; and Hades was following with him. Authority was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword and with famine and with pestilence and by the wild beasts of the earth.
- Re 6:9 When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained;
- Rev 6:10 They cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"
- Rev 6:11 And there was given to each of them a white robe; and they were told that they should rest for a little while longer, until [the number of] their fellow servants and their brethren who were to be killed even as they had been, would be completed also.
- Re 6:12 I looked when He broke the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake; & the sun became black as sackcloth *made* of hair, and the whole moon became like blood;
- Re 6:13 The stars of the sky fell to the earth, as a fig tree casts its unripe figs when shaken by a great wind.
- Re 6:14 The sky was split apart like a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.
- Re 6:15 Then the kings of the earth and the great men and the commanders and the rich and the strong and every slave and free man hid themselves in the caves and among the rocks of the mountains;
- Re 6:16 And they *\*said* to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the presence of Him who sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb;
- Re 6:17 For the great day of their wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"
- Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of those who were sealed, one hundred and forty-four thousand sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:
- Re 8:1 When the Lamb broke the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour.
- Re 8:2 And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.
- Re 8:3 Another angel came and stood at the altar, holding a golden censer; and much incense was given to him, so that he might add it to the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar which was before the throne.
- Re 8:4 And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, went up before God out of the angel's hand.
- Re 8:5 Then the angel took the censer and filled it with the fire of the altar, and threw it to the earth; and there followed peals of thunder and sounds and flashes of lightning and an earthquake.
- Re 8:8 The second angel sounded, and *something* like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea; and a third of the sea became blood,
- Re 8:9 And a third of the creatures which were in the sea and had life, died; and a third of the ships were destroyed.
- Re 8:12 The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck, so that a third of them would be darkened and the day would not shine for a third of it, and the night in the same way.
- Re 11:2 Leave out the court which is outside the temple and do not measure it, for it has been given to the nations; they will tread underfoot the holy city for forty-two months.
- Re 12:6 The woman fled into the wilderness where she had a place prepared by God, so that there she would be nourished for one thousand two hundred and sixty days.
- Re 12:14 But the two wings of the great eagle were given to the woman, so that she could fly into the wilderness to her place, where she *\*was* nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.
- Re 13:5 There was given to him a mouth speaking arrogant words and blasphemies, and authority to act for forty-two months was given to him.
- Re 13:12 He exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence. He makes the earth & those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose fatal wound was healed.
- Re 13:13 He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down out of heaven to the earth in the presence of men.
- Re 13:16 And he causes all, the small and the great, and the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead,
- Re 13:17 And *he provides* that no one will be able to buy or to sell, except the one who has the mark, *either* the name of the beast or the number of his name.

# Revelation Timeline Passages (NASB)

- Re 14:1 Then I looked, and behold, the Lamb was standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His name and the name of His Father written on their foreheads.
- Re 14:6 And I saw another angel flying in midheaven, having an eternal gospel to preach to those who live on the earth, and to every nation and tribe and tongue and people;
- Re 16:2 So the first *angel* went and poured out his bowl on the earth; and it became a loathsome and malignant sore on the people who had the mark of the beast and who worshiped his image.
- Re 16:3 The second *angel* poured out his bowl into the sea, and it became blood like *that* of a dead man; and every living thing in the sea died.
- Re 16:4 Then the third *angel* poured out his bowl into the rivers and the springs of waters; and they became blood.
- Re 16:8 The fourth *angel* poured out his bowl upon the sun, & it was given to it to scorch men with fire.
- Re 16:10 Then the fifth *angel* poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, & his kingdom became darkened; & they gnawed their tongues because of pain,
- Re 16:12 The sixth *angel* poured out his bowl on the great river, the Euphrates; & its water was dried up, so that the way would be prepared for the kings from the east.
- Re 16:17 Then the seventh *angel* poured out his bowl upon the air, & a loud voice came out of the temple from the throne, saying, "It is done."
- Re 16:18 And there were flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder; and there was a great earthquake, such as there had not been since man came to be upon the earth, so great an earthquake *was it, and* so mighty.
- Re 16:19 The great city was split into 3 parts, and the cities of the world fell. Babylon the great was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of His fierce wrath.
- Re 16:20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.
- Re 16:21 And huge hailstones, about one hundred pounds each, \*came down from heaven upon men; and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, because its plague \*was extremely severe.
- Re 19:6 Then I heard *something* like the voice of a great multitude & like the sound of many waters & like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns.
- Re 19:7 Let us rejoice & be glad & give the glory to Him, for the marriage of the Lamb has come & His bride has made herself ready.
- Re 19:8 It was given to her to clothe herself in fine linen, bright & clean; for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.
- Re 19:9 Then he \*said to me, "Write, 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb.'" & he \*said to me, "These are true words of God."
- Re 19:11 I saw heaven opened, & behold, a white horse, & He who sat on it *is* called Faithful & True, & in righteousness He judges & wages war.
- Re 19:12 His eyes *are* a flame of fire, & on His head *are* many diadems; & He has a name written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself.
- Re 19:13 *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood & His name is called The Word of God
- Re 19:14 The armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white & clean, were following Him on white horses.
- Re 19:15 From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, & He will rule them with a rod of iron; & He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty.
- Re 19:16 On His robe & on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, & LORD OF LORDS."
- Re 19:17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, & he cried out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds (vultures), "Come, assemble for the great supper of God
- Re 19:18 So that you may eat the flesh of kings & the flesh of commanders & the flesh of mighty men & the flesh of horses & of those who sit on them & the flesh of all men, both free men & slaves, & small & great.
- Re 19:19 I saw the beast & the kings of the earth & their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse & against His army.
- Re 19:20 The beast was seized, & with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast & those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.
- Re 19:21 The rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse, & all the birds were filled with their flesh.
- Re 20:2 He laid hold of the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil & Satan, & bound him for a thousand years;
- Re 20:3 He threw him into the abyss, & shut *it* & sealed *it* over him, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand years were completed; after these things he must be released for a short time.
- Re 20:4 Then I saw thrones, & they sat on them, & judgment was given to them. & I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus & because of the word of God, & those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, & had not received the mark on their forehead & on their hand; & they came to life & reigned with Christ for a thousand years.
- Re 20:5 The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed. This is the first resurrection.
- Re 20:6 Blessed & holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God & of Christ & will reign with Him for a thousand years.
- Re 20:7 When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison,
- Re 20:8 And will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog & Magog, to gather them together for the war; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore.
- Re 20:9 They came up on the broad plain of the earth & surrounded the camp of the saints & the beloved city, & fire came down from heaven & devoured them.
- Re 20:10 The devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire & brimstone, where the beast & the false prophet are also; & they will be tormented day & night forever & ever.
- Re 20:11 Then I saw a great white throne & Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth & heaven fled away, & no place was found for them.
- Re 20:12 I saw the dead, the great & the small, standing before the throne, & books were opened; & another book was opened, *the book* of life; & the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.
- Re 20:13 The sea gave up the dead which were in it, & death & Hades gave up the dead which were in them; & they were judged, according to their deeds.
- Re 20:14 Then death & Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire.
- Re 20:15 If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.
