5:12-14	 Final Thoughts From The Apostle Who Would Be Crucified Upside Down Silvanus/Silas – a faithful brother – who's there when you need help, a friendly voice, and encouragement We need to be a faithful friend, like Silas, to others Stand firm on God's word – the "true grace of God" There are others who have you on their minds and hearts (in this case, a sister church in Rome, and Mark) Always uplift other believers, including sister churches, in prayer Greet one another sincerely – not hypocritically If you get a smile, smile back even bigger If you get a handshake, grip back like a long-lost brother or sister If you get a hug, hug 'em even tighter & mean it
