INTRODUCTION

- Spiritual growth does not come automatically or by osmosis
- It takes intentional hard work over time
- It begins with KNOWLEDGE → the knowing what to do, when to do it, and how to do it
- Then to do things right, it takes DISCIPLINE, SELF-CONTROL, ENDURANCE, and the RIGHT ATTITUDE

2Peter 1:1-3	 Knowing God's Word Provides Grace and Peace v2. Peace is not the absence of conflict between us and others, but between us and God If there is harmony between us and God, we are in God's will and we will get our prayers answered God also provides Grace or providential blessings as needed to accomplish His will KNOWLEDGE IS THE PRIMARY KEY. This grace (providential blessings) and peace with God begins with intimately knowing God's word and obeying it We are also "blessed with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ"
1:4	 What are some of these "Great and Precious Promises" that enable us to "Escape Corruption"? Deut 4:40 So you shall keep His statutes and His commandments that it may go well with you and with your children & that you may live long on the land Joshua 1:7be careful to do according to all the law which was given to you; so, you may have success wherever you go. Psalm 37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide. Psalm 119:11 Your word I have treasured in my heart, that I may not sin against You. Matt 6:33 But seek first His kingdom & righteousness, and all these things (essentials of life – food, drink, and clothing) will be provided to you. 1:10-11	Recalling God's Truth Strengthens Our Foundation v10a. "Give diligence to make your calling and election sure" – or, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works & glorify God"Mt 5:16 v10b. "if you do these things, you shall never fail." Theoretically, it is possible to live a sinless life. After all, Christ was our example, and since we have "every spiritual blessings in heavenly places", and a way to escape out of every temptation, we have no excuse. v11. Motivation: There awaits for us a glorious future
