## INTRODUCTION

- Moses had 80 years of training to lead the Israelites to their promised land (40 in Egypt & 40 as a shepherd), and it still seemed it wasn't enough time
- The Song of Moses summarizes God's wonders during Israel's march out of Egypt; and we see God providing sustenance while Israel continually yearned for more stuff. How grateful are we with God's provisions?
- God met the needs of the Jews on a daily basis. Why not provide a weekly or monthly surplus to give them more comfort & confidence?

Exodus 15:1-21	<ul> <li>The Song of Moses</li> <li>v3. God is called a warrior, literally "a man of battle"</li> <li>v6and God's Right Hand shatters His enemies</li> <li>King David says that God taught his hands to war and his fingers to fight</li></ul>		
	v20. First incidence of Dancing. Is it right or wrong to Dance?		
What is Right or Wrong with Dancing?	<ul> <li>Dancing is mentioned 24x in the Bible (19x in the OT)</li> <li>Dancing is portrayed negatively or sensually in 2 incidences:         <ol> <li>Ex 32:19-28 – Jews danced (out of control) before an idol, resulting in 3,000 men being slain with a sword</li> <li>Mark 6:22 – The dancing of Herodias' daughter pleased Herod and his guests, whereby John the Baptist was slain</li> </ol> </li> <li>Dancing is portrayed positively in all other passages:         <ol> <li>2Sam 6:14 – David danced to the LORD with all his might</li> <li>Ps 30:11 – God can turn our mourning into dancing</li> <li>Ps 150:4 – We are to praise God with music and dancing</li> <li>Ecc 3:4 – There is a time to mourn and a time to dance</li> </ol> </li> <li>Conclusions → Liberty vs Legalism vs Licentiousness:         <ol> <li>Provocative dancing seems to get men killed in the Bible, so avoid pole dancing &amp; dancing with another's spouse</li> <li>We cannot be dogmatic or legalist and declare all forms of dancing as sinful or unbiblical. There is liberty in Christ.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>		
Exodus 15:22-27	First Water Purifier  • vv22-24. Provisions are gone after walking 3 days. The only watering hole is polluted – so what do grumblers do best?  • v25. Moses "cries out" to the Lord. How would you cry out?  • It is a good thing Moses' prayer is not recorded for us, cause many people would use it as a magical formula  • Prayers are meant to be personal chats with God our Father and not recited formulas or "meaningless repetition" of many words as the heathens doMat 6:7  •and the Lord "showed" Moses a tree to sweeten the waters (how the tree sweetened the waters is unknown)  • The Lord possibly showed the tree to Moses by His physical presence either through the Holy Spirit or a Christophany		

Passage	Comments
Exodus 16	<ul> <li>Manna, Meat, and the Sabbath</li> <li>vv1-21. More grumbling on day 45 over not having any meat (How soon former slaves forgot the misery they had in Egypt)</li> <li>Manna ("what is it") is provided for 40 years, 6 days/week</li> <li>Other 40-year miracles included their clothes and sandals never wore out, and feet didn't swell</li></ul>
Exodus 17	More Grumbling for More WATER  When is grumbling or complaining about a bad situation OK?  Even righteous Job got chastised by God for complaining against Him
Exodus 18	won't happen till centuries later

## **CONCLUSION / APPLICATIONS / CONSIDERATIONS**

- Even when they complained, God's response, like a loving parent, was to provide for them and give them another chance to obey
- God's provisions were strictly according to the people's needs, no more and no less, and they were not to hoard God's provisions – WHY?
- The Jews had to learn to completely be reliant on Him for all their needs each and every day → His mercies are new every day .....Lam 3:22-23
- How do we rely on God on a daily basis?
