Two of the 4 rivers are unknown (Pishon & Gihon) The land marks Moses gave were probably provided by reliable testimonials and written records attained from Shem (son of Noah) who was still living during the times of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob Also Moses even had access to "written accounts" from the
