## INTRODUCTION

- Genesis is more than simple stories of creation, the flood, and genealogies. Genesis touches on all major Bible doctrines
- Genesis covers 3 of the 7 covenants and 4 of the 7 dispensations
- - Covenant theology is primarily non-literalist or allegorist and equates the New Testament Church to Old Testament Israel
  - Dispensational theology sees Israel and the Church as two distinct entities since we follow a more literal interpretation
    - 1. E.g., all prophecies relating to Christ were literally fulfilled, not figuratively. His future coming is also literal
    - 2. Also, if the NT church are able to claim the promises of Israel, as "Name-it & Claim-it" pundits proclaim, then we should also be open to receive the judgments pronounced on Israel


