**INTRODUCTION**

- Israel/Judah was getting hit with a 1-2 punch with while Isaiah prophesied in Jerusalem & Micah prophesied in the outskirts of town
- Government and religious leaders do not become evil and corrupt leaders over night. Usually, they start with small ethical issues, then they migrate over to whomever pays them the most
- Same here in Micah. The rulers of his day were as corrupt as we see in our day and times
  - ♦ They hate good and love evil
  - ♦ They pray, but God does not answer
  - ♦ They are unjust, unmerciful
  - ♦ They teach and preach just for the money
  - ♦ They think God will do them no harm

Passage	Comments
1:1-4	<b>God will come down from His place to tread on the earth</b> • IOW, it is time for Gloom & Doom – at least for Israel/Judah
1:5-6	• Samaria, the capital of the Northern Kingdom is the cause of Jacob/Israel's downfall. Makes us wonder if Washington, DC is the catalyst of ruin for our nation. Is it?
1:7	• Harlot wages will go to another harlot! How will this be?
1:8-12	• Micah might have walked barefoot and naked like Isaiah (Isaiah 20:2) to powerfully illustrate Israel's pending doom • v9. Her wound is incurable ♦ Reminiscent of 1John 5:16 – Sin unto Death – No Hope
1:13-15	• Lachish – another big city of sin. When you think of cities like New York, Chicago, LA, Tokyo – one thinks of all the headaches of a big city (crime, homelessness, fear)
1:16	"Make yourself BALD" equates to rightful morning
2:1-5	<b>Woe to those who scheme</b> • Directed primarily against wealthy landowners • Injustice against the poor is one of God's pet peeves
2:6-7	<b>God's answer against false prophets</b> • His words do good to those who walk righteously
2:8-9	<b>The rich seem to get richer</b> • ...by robbing from the poor and weak.....of Psalm 73:12
2:10	• Possible principle when to leave a sinful place, be it a church, a home, or a nation. Flee when persecuted? .....Mt 10:23
2:11	<b>I will speak to you of wine and beer</b> • IOW, I will speak to you of prosperity! But when? Millennium?
2:12	<b>God will always have His remnant.</b> • Remember, all of Israel were Jews, but not all of Israel are saved .....Rom 9:6
2:13	<b>The "breaker" is presumably Jesus Christ</b> • He breaks the seals in Revelation 5
3:1	<b>Rulers should know how to dispense true justice</b> • ...but they do not. Do we see this in our nation today? ♦ The poor suffer the most ♦ The rich get richer ♦ The rich rulers profit from people's misery
3:2a	<b>The rulers have reversed morality</b> • They call good evil and evil good • Do we see this happening today? E.g., Abortions are good!

Passage	Comments
3:2b-3	<b>The rulers basically devour the weak – God's people.</b> • In other words, they squeeze blood out of a turnip
3:4	• What time period is "THEN" referring to? Probably, the time of Samaria's destruction, recorded in Micah 1:6-8; 2:3 • Who are "THEY" in "They will cry out to God, but He will not answer them"? They are corrupt officials, prophets, & priests
3:5	<b>How bad are the corrupt prophets, &amp; priests of God?</b> ♦ Bad enough to take bribes ♦ They render prophecies of "PEACE" to those who give them something ♦ They declare "Jihad" or "holy war" on those who do not bribe them
<b>NOTE</b>	In our "Times of the Gentiles" we are no longer under a curse if we do not give to God's work. But we stand to lose blessings if we are stingy. He who sows much will reap much.....2Cor 9:6
3:6-7	<b>God will clam up and hide Himself from those corrupt rulers</b> • The result is people are left to fend for themselves as their leadership become powerless and useless – The nation crumbles. If there is no vision, the people perish..... Prov 29:18
3:8-10	<b>Micah is one small voice</b> • How do today's political/religious leaders "abhor justice"? • How do today's political/religious leaders twist what is straight? • How do today's political/religious leaders build our nation with blood and injustice
3:11	• Micah calls the baby ugly by saying the Government and religious systems follow the money trail ♦ <b>Is this true of our times?</b> • Yet, the rulers say no harm will come to the nation since God is still on their side. <b>Is this true?</b>
3:12	<b>NOPE. God has no problems wiping the slate clean again</b> • He wiped the early humans out, except Noah and his clan • He wiped Sodom & Gomorrah off the map • He let the Ark of the Covenant disappear • He allowed His temple to be destroyed 3 times • What will it take to wake His people up? To wake US up?

- Listen up when God speaks words of Doom

- Run away from sin
- Stay alert to who is corrupt and who is not
- Challenge wrong behavior but leave it in God's hands if we are not able to change things
