INTRODUCTION

- Everybody has their Achilles heel, which Satan loves to exploit:
 - ♦ Money/Greed Judas
 - ♦ Anger/Emotions Cain
 - ♦ Alcohol/Drugs Lot
 - ♦ Sex/Lusts King David, Solomon, Samson
- Satan can't read our minds, but he can watch our eye movements and our wallet, and tell where our heart is each and every day:
 - ♦ Do we linger too long on something or someone?
 - ♦ Do we give too much attention to something or someone?
- Solomon knew firsthand the dangers of immorality
 - ♦ His Dad (King David) almost lost his kingdom because of it
 - ♦ Two of his brothers died as a result of immorality
 - ♦ His sister was raped by one of his brothers, which spun the family out of control
 - ♦ ...and Solomon's heart was turned away from God because of it
- How does God define Moral Purity?
- What happens to society when morals are lax with no restraints?
 - ♦ Rampant single-parents; Unruly kids; High suicide rate; STDs;
 - ♦ Increase in drugs/alcohol abuse, sexual abuse, moral decay

Passage	Comments
	<p>Can Satan/demons put thoughts into our minds?... No</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We can buy into Satan's lies and deceptions (e.g., King David, Peter, Judas, Ananias & Sapphira), yet, we are totally accountable for acting on any thoughts we have <p>Our hearts/minds are known only by God, since it is part of His divine attribute..... Ps 139:1-4; Jn 2:23-25</p>
5:15-19	<p>The Joys of Marriage</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God meant marriage to reflect the ultimate intimacy between Man & God; and He is a jealous God • As God should be our only God, our spouse should be our only spouse
5:20-23	<p>The Vital Importance of Self-Discipline</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • v20. WHY chase after forbidden fruit? No logical sense • v21. God knows all, sees all, judges all • vv22-23. All other sins are outside the body (temporal), but sexual sins last a lifetime..... 1Corinthians 6:18 • We must define and take steps to protect ourselves and our loved ones from sexual predation • What are some of those steps?
6:20-35	<p>The Way to Avert Disaster</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • vv20-22. Listen up & Learn. Observe God's words, do not forsake them, but bind them, tie them – so they may guide you, watch over you, & talk to youHOW? • v23. God's word acts like a light to clearly show us the path we need to take – and we must discipline ourselves to read and heed; to flee or fight • vv24-25. How do we avoid being seduced? It begins with the mind. You must willingly choose to live right <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ "I made a covenant with my eyes not to gaze at a virgin"..... Job 31:1 • vv26-29. Hollywood portrays sex as freely available, and free of any consequences, BUT there is always a high cost for adultery and fornication • vv30-33. An adulterer lacks "sense" – They are a brick shy of a full load, their elevator doesn't go to the top • vv34-35. Some say that "Hell hath no fury like a woman scorned" but the Bible says a jealous husband will not be appeased till he is avenged

Passage	Comments
Proverbs 5:1-14	<p>The Dangers of Immorality</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • vv1-2. Listen up and Learn. We have to make the effort • v3. Seduction is so enticing. All the senses are affected (Smells good, looks, feels, sounds, and tastes good) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ The most powerful temptation most deal with is their sexual drive; After all, the 1st command God gave to Man was to "Go have sex, multiply, and fill the earth" ♦ Satan loves to distort God's good creation ♦ God took sex so seriously between the man and wife, the death penalty was for any hanky-panky • v5. Immorality leads to destruction – ultimately death • v6. The wicked do not consider the consequences. They live for the moment.....Lamentations 1:9 • v7. Again, Listen up and Learn – this is IMPORTANT • v8. Keep your distance. Flee youthful lusts. Don't flirt. The stronger the temptation, the greater the distance • vv9-11. You will end up paying others for your indiscretion. Immorality is not cheap, financially & physically • vv12-13. A few minutes of pleasure for a lifetime of regret – Why didn't I listen? Why did I cave in? • v14. Result is utter ruin – and everybody knows!!!
Limitations of Satan and Demons	<p>Can Satan and his demons read our thoughts?.....No</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Bible never says explicitly that Satan cannot know our thoughts or read our minds, but it never shows him doing it and it implies that he cannot read minds <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Example. When Satan asked God's permission to torment Job, it was due to Job's outward character that was for all to see, which reflected his inward self
