Exodus 2-4	 Moses saved by Pharoah's daughter Moses' own mother nurses him in Pharoah's house Moses received the best private education Moses flees Egypt and ends up taking care of sheep for 40 years Moses happens to work by the place called "Holy Ground" and sees the burning bush Aaron, his brother, just happens to be passing by and becomes Moses' spokesman since God did not heal his stuttering problem

Num 11 Num 14 Num 16 Num 21 Num 25	 Moses pleads with God not to annihilate the Jews, and Moses has the Levites slay about 3000 men for worshipping the golden calf Israel forced to wander the wilderness for 40 yrs A fire of the Lord came down to eliminate some grumblers in the outlying parts of the camp God slays more than 14,000 grumblers with quail and a plague God slays 10 out of 12 spies for bringing a bad report A Sabbath-breaker is executed A profaner/blasphemer is executed Korah's rebellion – an earthquake swallows Korah's clan, and a fire consumed 250 others Fiery serpents slay more grumblers Phinehas runs a spear through an adulterer and his Midianite girlfriend to allow God to begin blessing the Israelites again 		
Psalm 105:1-2	 God wants His people to proclaim His mighty works to others and even to echo them back to Him It is not that God needs to hear all the good things He does for us – BUT we need to tell them 		
105:4	Seek God's Presence Continually		
105:5	 Remember God's wondrous works We are very forgetful creatures, so we have to force ourselves to remember good things It's funny how easy it is to remember bad things 		
105:6-44	Recollection of the Exodus		
105:45	 Purpose of the Exodus – so that God's people would keep His statutes and observe His laws BUT did they? Half-heartedly maybe YET, God is still worthy of our praise for His patience with us and His sustaining grace
