## INTRODUCTION

- Psalm 119 is the longest chapter in the Bible (176 verses)
- Possibly written by **Ezra** the Scribe who prepared his heart to study God's word (Ezra 7:10), and who by Jewish tradition collected and compiled the Old Testament into the divisions we now have following the return from Babylonian captivity
- The Psalm is an acrostic poem divided into 22 parts each 8 stanzas, and each part begins with the same Hebrew letter:

minutes), you can finish the Bible in 90-100 days
