**INTRODUCTION**

- Can we prove to the world that God exists? ..... Yes & No
- God is a God who hides Himself (**Isaiah 8:17**), but when we honestly examine the evidence, we see God's fingerprints everywhere. Others won't believe even if someone rose from the dead ..... **Luke 16:31**
- God made it theoretically possible for every able-minded person throughout all of history to make it to Heaven. So, when someone ends up in Hell, they can only blame themselves

Romans 1:18-23	<p><b>Doctrine of Natural Revelation – No Excuse</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• vv18-19. Though God has given them internal and external evidence, the unrighteous suppress the truth                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ What internal evidence has God provided?                             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. God has instilled in the heart of everyone a realization of eternity ..... <b>Ecc 3:11</b></li> <li>2. God's moral Law of right and wrong are attested by the conscience ..... <b>Rom 2:15</b></li> </ol> </li> <li>♦ But the conscience can be made weak (<b>1Cor 8:12</b>); or defiled (<b>Titus 1:15</b>); evil (<b>Heb 10:22</b>); shipwrecked (<b>1Tim 1:19</b>); or seared (<b>1Tim 4:2</b>) thru intentional self-deception (<b>1Cor 3:18; Jam 1:26</b>)</li> <li>♦ What external evidence has God provided?                             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Substantial proof for the Resurrection .. <b>Acts 17:31</b></li> <li>2. Scientific proof through the laws of mathematical probability: The odds of only 8 Messianic prophecies being fulfilled in one person is at least 1x10<sup>28</sup>. For any more prophecies to be fulfilled would astronomically be impossible for them to refer to any other person than Jesus Christ</li> </ol> </li> </ul> </li> <li>• vv20-23. Since the creation, God's invisible attributes are visible (omniscience, omnipresence, all powerful, all loving, all just, all merciful) ..... <b>BUT HOW?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ <b>Power/Truth/Just/Righteous.</b> E.g., finding billions of dead things buried in rock layers all over the world give credence to Noah's global flood</li> <li>♦ <b>Mercy/Love.</b> Mankind is still here</li> <li>♦ <b>Omniscience.</b> The complexity of life, the vastness of the universe, and beauty found everywhere</li> <li>♦ <b>Omnipresence.</b> If God's word is true, then His presence is everywhere, as testified ..... <b>Ps 139:8</b></li> </ul> </li> </ul>
1:24-25	<p><b>God Gave Them Over to Their Lusts</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• v24. What would this look like? Probable sins include:                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Loose living, few morals, most anything goes</li> <li>♦ The sad part is there would be countless innocent victims from child prostitution, incest, rape, pornography, and exploited women &amp; children</li> </ul> </li> <li>• v25. "Served the creature" – What does this look like?                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Man determines his ways. Man becomes God.</li> <li>♦ Truth becomes relevant, not absolute</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

1:26-27	<p><b>God Gave Them Over to Degrading Passions</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As they went from bad to worse, what would it be like?                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Sins of Rome included acceptance and promotion of adultery, homosexuality, bestiality, pedophilia, and child sacrifice on a national scale</li> <li>♦ Seems like America today (abortion, gay rights, uncontested divorce and remarriage). Bestiality &amp; pedophilia are next on the agenda</li> </ul> </li> <li>• v27b. "...receiving in their own persons the due penalty of their error". IOW, they reaped what they sowed on a national scale. What would this look like?                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Sexually transmitted diseases</li> <li>♦ Broken families, no one knows what sex they are</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
1:28-32	<p><b>God Gave Them Over to a Depraved Mind</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• "...they wax worse &amp; worse..... <b>2Tim 3:13</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ What would this look like? Probable sins include masochism, sadism, and other sexual perversions not appropriate to even talk about..... <b>Eph 5:12</b></li> </ul> </li> <li>• v28. BUT what does it mean "God gave them over..."?                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ Consider this: God allowed them to do the evil they concocted with no forms of corrective punishment</li> <li>♦ Unfortunately, this would mean punishment would come later, possibly when they stood before God's judgment seat.                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>♦ ...and there would be many innocent victims between now and then...OUCH</li> </ul> </li> <li>♦ What can the Church do? <input type="checkbox"/> Challenge society? <input type="checkbox"/> Preach against such sins? <input type="checkbox"/> Do nothing but wait?</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Food for Thought.</b> If the Church condones and promotes adultery via remarrying of divorcees, how can we tell the world homosexuality is wrong without it being hypocritical? Remember, adultery is considered an abomination and is lumped in with homosexuality as a deadly sin ..... <b>1Cor 6:9-10; Gal 5:19-21; Ezek 22:11</b></li> </ul>
